I even declared to my mother-in-law that I would NEVER pray the Rosary, to which she replied, "Oh Honey, don't worry about it. Someday, you will." Well, as you can guess, God had other plans for me. The quiet witness of my husband and my mother-in-law's deep devotion to the Rosary ignited my Catholic faith.

He delivered me in many ways.

The healing I experienced through the study and retreat prepared me to give my fiat when Regional Coordinator Martha Nicolli asked me to co-facilitate the study with her. I accepted the call and have been facilitating for the past eight years, each time learning as much as the women I lead.

Through the many healing resources and events available through Women of Grace, I was finally able to let go of all those negative feelings. After three years of praying and wrestling with the right thing to do, I went to the cemetery and found the strength to kneel and pray at the grave of the person who had molested me and tell him I forgave him. I hung a Rosary on his headstone and left unburdened. Two years later, I returned and saw the beads scattered next to a medal of Our Blessed Mother. I realized that Jesus had given me His Mother to walk with me, pick up the pieces of my life, and heal my brokenness.
